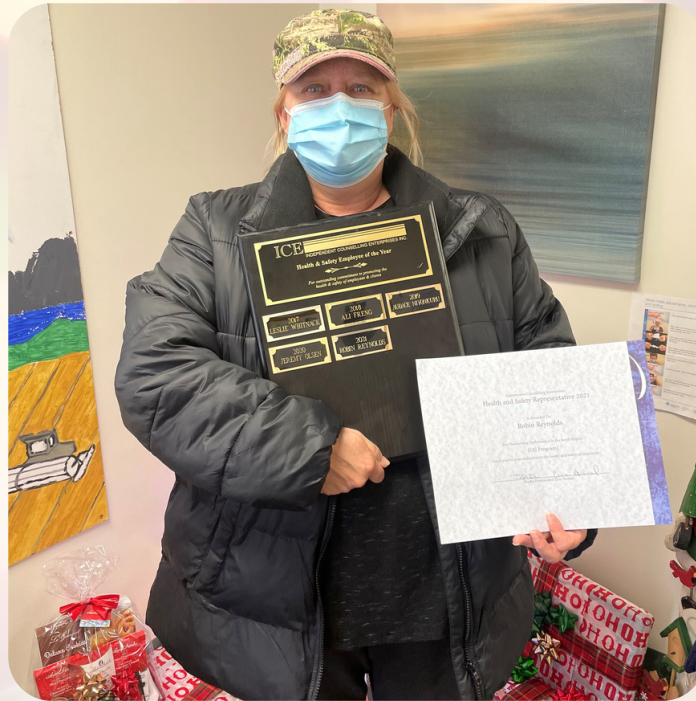

## Health and Safety Award

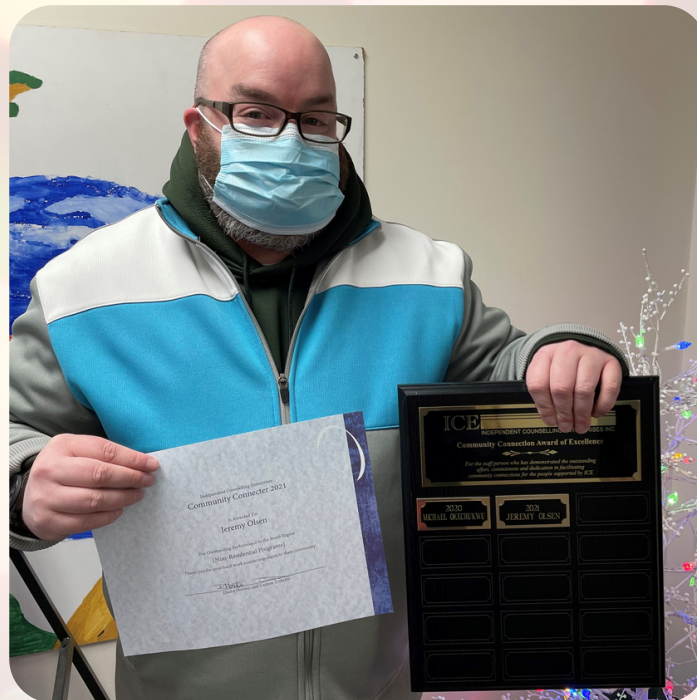


**Robin Reynolds**
